- Please bring a fresh stool sample to your visits for us to examine for intestinal parasites.
- Your cat needs to be kept on Flea and Tick prevention <u>year round.</u>
- If your cat is outdoors, retest for Feline Leukemia/ FIV yearly and keep updated on Feline Leukemia Vaccine.
