First Puppy Visit: AGE 6-9 WEEKS OLD

- Physical Exam
- Distemper, Hepatitis, and Parvovirus Combo Vaccine.
- □ Intestinal Parasite Exam (Stool sample check)
- □ Start Heartworm prevention and Flea/Tick prevention.

Second Puppy Visit: AGE 9-12 WEEKS OLD

- Physical Exam
- Distemper, Hepatitis, Parvovirus Combo Vaccine. (2nd)
- Bordetella Vaccine
- □ Intestinal Parasite Exam (Stool sample check)
- □ Heartworm prevention, Flea/Tick prevention.

Third Puppy Visit: AGE 12-15 WEEKS OLD

- Physical Exam
- Distemper, Hepatitis, Parvovirus Combo Vaccine. (3rd)
- □ Rabies 1 year Vaccine
- □ Intestinal Parasite Exam (if 2 previous were not Negative)
- □ Heartworm prevention, Flea and Tick prevention.

Fourth Puppy Visit: AGE 16 WEEKS AND OLDER

- Physical Exam
- Distemper, Hepatitis, Parvovirus Combo Vaccine 1yr.
- □ Start Leptospirosis and/ or Lyme Vaccine Series.
- □ 6 months supply of Heartworm, Flea and Tick prevention.

Please return promptly and schedule appointments appropriately for vaccine updates, as your puppy is not fully protected against these diseases until the vaccine series are completed. Try to keep your puppy isolated from other dogs until vaccine series are

completed.

- We recommend Spaying/Neutering your pet at around 6 months of age.
- Please bring a fresh stool sample to your visits for us to examine for intestinal parasites.
- Your dog needs to be kept on Heartworm Prevention and Flea & Tick Prevention year round.
